

PARTS LIST:







1. INSTALLING YOUR ROOF TOP TENT

 a) You must have roof racks correctly fitted to your vehicle before installling the Roof Top Tent



1. b) We recommend you place the Roof Top Tent in the load-bearing position




1. c) Adjust the tent to the roofs centre, ensuring the rear door can be opened/closed



1. d) Slide the M8X50 hexagon bolts into the rails from both sides ensuring you have positioned 8 in total (see picture 1)
Washer

1. e) Replace the plastic covers of your roof racks (see picture 2)



Plastic nut

1. f) Use the plastic nut, flat and arc washer to fix the M8X50 hexagon head bolt and U-shape stator in place to all four corners.

(see picture 3)

2. SETTING UP YOUR ROOF TOP TENT

2. a) Open the tent cover and run the power cord to your 12V socket



2. b) Ensure that power has ran from your car to the tent, press "UP" on your remote control to set up the tent

(Notice: The "DOWN" button would not function until the tent is fully setting up. Pressing "STOP" button for 1s to stop setting up firstly if you need to set down the tent in the process of setting up.)



2. c) Wait a couple of minutes for the tent to set up automatically



3. PACKING DOWN YOUR ROOF TOP TENT

3. a) Secure yourself safely on the ladder, release the stay bar from the cross pole, position the stay bar to the original position



b) Unlock the ladder by pushing the ladder lock on the bottom step



and place inside the tent



3. d) Ensure the power has ran to the tent from your car and press the "DOWN" button on the remote (Notice: The "UP" button would not function until the tent is fully setting down. Pressing "STOP" button for 1s for stopping the setting down firstly if you need to set up the tent in the process of setting down.)



3. e) Wait a couple of minutes for the tent to fold down automatically



3. f) Remove power cord from 12V socket and cover the Roof top Tent



4. TIPS & TRICKS

- Always ensure the tent is dry before packing away
- Keep the rail of the motorised pushing rod clean
- Ensure ladder is always locked into place and angled away from vehicle

If your Roof Top Tent won't open, check the following:

- A. The power cord has been inserted into the 12V socket correctly

 In purpose of protecting the motor against the surge current generated by revering action (UP TO DOWN or DOWN TO UP), the product is built-in protection to avoid directly changing motor direction. Under this protection, the motor direction cannot be changed during tent moving process by pressing "DOWN" or "UP" button directly. Press "STOP" button to stop the moving process and then press "DOWN" or "UP" button for changing the setting direction.
- B. Check that no objects are in the tent, check to ensure nothing is caught on the motorised rod
- **C.** If the above checks have been completed and still the Roof Top Tent won't automatically open, check to see if the motorised pushing rod is damaged
- **D.** If damaged you will need to install a new motorised pushing rod by following the instructions on the following page

TROUBLE SHOOTING:

1. Open the plastic part on the side of frame



2. Pull out the white transmission wire carefully



3. Unscrew the waterproof joint



4. Disconnect the waterproof joint



5. Pull out the transmission wire from the frame hole right above



6. Pull out the waterproof joint




7. Use big size hexagon wrench to screw off the nut on the frame



8. Use small size hexagon wrench to screw off the nut on the tent pole



Install the new motorize pushing rod (assemble step is opposite to disassemble step)
