INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Each stand shall be supplied with clear instructions explaining the safe use of the stand. The instructions shall include the following recommendations:

- Confirm that the load to be applied does not exceed the working load limit of the vehicle support stands.
- Conduct a pre-operational check of the equipment.
- Use vehicle support stands on a hard level surface, such as concrete.
- Use vehicle support stands in pairs.
- Check that no part of the underbody of the vehicle will foul as the stands are positioned.
- Ensure that each stand is securely located under a strong point of the vehicle. Consult the vehicle manufacturer's manual for guidance.
- Ensure that the locking mechanism is fully engaged.
- Chock the unlifted wheels of the vehicle.
- Do not extend the height of the stand beyond its maximum working height, nor use any item such as bricks or timber to support the vehicle.
- Modifications MUST NOT be carried out or accessories added.

ASSEMBLY & OPERATION

CONSULT PARTS DIAGRAM BEFORE READING THIS SECTION

INSPECTION:

• Inspect the car stands before each use. If the car stands or any part of them is in anyway bent, broken or cracked, the stands should not be used.

ASSEMBLY:

- 1. Insert ratchet bar into the stand frame.
- 2. Bend tab inwards to prevent ratchet bar exceeding maximum height during use.

OPERATION:

- 1. Slide car stands to the proper position points referred to in the vehicle manufacturer's manual. Make sure the car stands are on the same point on each side of the vehicle. Raise the car stands until they are just below the jack contact point of the vehicle.
- 2. Centre the load on the saddle of the ratchet bar. Gently lower the vehicle with jack.

It may drop down a very small amount until the ratchet bar catches on the ratchet handle. Repeat on the other side.

- 3. Always use car stands in pairs and only on parts of a vehicle that car sustain the load. Consult the vehicle manufacturer's manual for the correct lift and support points.
- 4. Check to ensure that the load is secured and stable before commencing work under the vehicle.

REMOVING:

- 1. Raise the vehicle with a jack to take the load off the car stands.
- 2. Raise the ratchet handle on the car stands and lower the ratchet bar.
- 3. Remove the car stands. Use the floor jack to safely lower the vehicle to the ground.
